



Testing assumptions – Waterfall Projects


- Testing must be independent from development
- Testing cannot start before coding is finished
- Testing follows the sequence of (1) test case design, (2) test case execution, (3) test case reporting
- There must be a "Test plan"
- 100% test coverage is too expensive
- 100% test automation is too expensive
- Testing must be done by 'testers'




Moving from Waterfall to Agile













Testing in Agile






The regression testing challenge – automation






Test Driven Development
