## Criteria for becoming an Accredited Instructor



The DevOps Institute Instructor Program provides individuals and organizations with resources and opportunities to grow the business while supporting client needs in a manner that makes sense for everyone through minimal barriers to entry while ensuring quality course deliveries. To become an Accredited Instructor, an applicant will need to:

- Have demonstrable experience, credentials, and subject matter expertise on the course topic
- Have at least one year of active proven training experience or extensive DevOps experience
- Successfully pass (or have passed) the appropriate course certification with a minimum of 65%
- \$250 USD annual Instructor Accreditation Fee (Accredited Instructors will receive Trainer Self-Study (TSS) materials and one free exam voucher annually. Discounts will be provided for additional exam vouchers. Corresponding TSS materials are included with each exam voucher). Train the Trainer Workshops are excluded from free and discounted exam vouchers.
- If the Instructor is not registered with an accredited Education Partner, the Instructor will need to also be set-up as an accredited Education Partner. In order to obtain the TSS materials and correlating exam voucher, the Instructor must first be currently accredited and listed under a currently accredited Education Partner.
